



MassCat Policy Regarding Records for Electronic Resources

MassCat recognizes the increasing number of electronic resources available to member libraries. While these electronic resources may prove valuable to an individual member library and its constituents, MassCat realizes that these licensed materials may not be readily accessible to the constituents of other member libraries. Because of this lack of ready accessibility, only records for subscription-based electronic resources that all MassCat member libraries have access to will be accepted.

If an electronic resource licensed by a member library is also available in print in that library's collection, or can be copied by the library holding the license to the electronic resource, then a record for that electronic resource can be made available in the MassCat database. If the electronic resource is only available to card holders of a particular member library, and cannot be reproduced in some form for constituents of another MassCat member library, then a record for that electronic resource cannot be made available in the MassCat database.
